τοῦτο, τὸ συνδευτικὸν τοῦ ἀκτινωτοῦ δίσκου (cd) διὰ
τὴν μουσικὴν συναύλιαν διοργάνωσαν ὑφ' ἡμῶν,
ἀποσκοποῦσαν καταδεῖξην τὴν στενὴν σχέσην μεταξὺ¹
ἀνθρωπότητος, περιβάλλοντος καὶ τέχνης.

Τὰ τελευταῖα χρόνια διόλοι μας ἔγνωρίσαμεν πόσον
καταστροφική δύναται η κτίσις ἀπὸ τὸν Δημιουργὸν
τῆς Ὀνορού, κατὰ τὸν Μ. Βασιλεῖον, ἔφερε τὸν
κόσμον εἰς τὴν ὑπάρχην ἀπὸ τὴν ἀνυπαρξίαν, κινούμενος
ἀπὸ θείην ἄγαντιν. Κάθε φοράν ποὺ τὸ ἐνδιαφέρον μας διὰ τὸν κόσμον περιορίζεται εἰς τὰ ἐγνωτικά
μας συμφέροντα – εἰτε οἰκονομικά εἴτε πολιτικά εἶναι
αὐτά – ἀμελούμεν τὴν τελεολογίαν τῆς σχέσεώς μας πρὸς
τὸν κόσμον, τὴν ὄποιαν ἐνεπιστεύθη ἡμᾶς ὁ Θεός: νὰ
προσευχώμεθα καὶ νὰ ἐργάζωμεθα διὰ τὴν μεταρρύφωσην
τοῦ λοκλίτου τοῦ κόσμου. Πάντοτε ἔχομεν τὴν βεβαίαν
πεποίθησην ότι ἡ περιβαλλοντική κρίσις τῆς ἐποχῆς μας
δεν εἶναι μόνο τεχνογνοί, ἀλλὰ περιλαμβάνει ἐνθάδε
μυαλικὸν καὶ θήματον πρόβλημα. Μόνον ὅταν ἀνοίγουμεν
τοὺς ἔαυτούς μας πρὸς τοὺς ἄλλους, πρὸς τὸν κτίσιν καὶ
πρὸς τὸν Θεόν, ήμπορούμεν νὰ ἐνθυμηθῶμε ταπεινῶς
τὴν θέσην μας εἰς τὸ σύμπαν καὶ νὰ σεβασθῶμεν, ὅπως
ἀρμάζει, ὀλούς τοὺς ἀνθρώπους (καθὼς ἐξημοργήθησαν
καθ' ὄμοιόν του θεοῦ), ἀλλὰ καὶ ὅλα τὰ κτίσματά Τοῦ,
καθ' ὅτι καὶ αὐτά ἐδημιουργήθησαν ὑπ' Αὐτοῦ.

Η τέχνη καὶ ἡ μουσικὴ ἀποτελοῦν τρόπους πνευματικούς, οἱ ὄποιαὶ μᾶς δίδουν τὴν δυνατότητα νὰ ἀνοιχθεῖν
πρὸς τὴν πνευματικὴν διάστασιν τοῦ κόσμου. Διότι εἰς
τὴν ἀναζήτησιν τῶν θείων στοιχείων τῆς ὄμορφιάς του
κόσμου, ἡ μουσικὴ καὶ ἡ τέχνη μᾶς δίδουν τὴν δυνατότητα
νὰ λαβώμεν γένεσιν τῆς τελεότητος τοῦ παραδείσου ἀν
καὶ εὐρισκόμενα δάκμα εἰς τὴν γῆν. Διὰ τὸν λόγον τούτου
ὁ ἀοιδόμορφος πρακτόρος, ἡμῶν Πατριάρχης Δημήτριος
ἀνέθεσε εἰς τὸν ἀείνυντον Υμνογράφον τῆς καθ' ἡμάς
Ἄγιας τοῦ Χριστοῦ Μεγάλου Εκκλησίας Μοναχὸν Γεράσιμον
Μικραγιαννανίτην νὰ συνθέσῃ ἵερον Ακολουθιαν διὰ
τὴν προστασίαν τοῦ φυσικοῦ περιβάλλοντος. Η μουσικὴ²
λοιπὸν ἔκτελει τῆς Ακολουθίας ταύτης, ὑπὸ τῆς ὑπὸ³
τὴν διεύθυνσιν τοῦ Μουσικολογικούτατος κ. Λυκούργου
Ἀγγελοπούλου, Αρχοντος Πρωτοψάλτου τῆς Αγιαστῆς
Ἀρχεπισκοπῆς Κωνσταντινούπολεως, εὐρύτατης γνωστῆς
χορωδίας, ἀπότελε τὸν μᾶλλον εὐγάντων τρόπον διὰ νὰ
ἀντιληφθῶμεν τὸν ὄρθρον τρόπουν συμπειφορᾶς μας πρὸς


PART A

ΓΕΡΑΣΙΜΟΣ ΜΙΚΡΑΓΙΑΝΝΑΝΙΤΗΣ

Ο Γεράσιμος Μικραγιαννάνης (1905 – 1991), κατά κόσμον Αναστάσιος - Αθανάσιος, γιος τού Ιωάννη Γραίκα και της Αθηνάς Δρόσου, γεννήθηκε στη Δρόβιανη τής έπαρχιας Δελτίνου Βορείου Ήπειρου.

Το 1919 μετοίκησε μέ τόν πατέρα του στην Αθήνα, προκειμένου νά έργασθούν γιά νά βοηθήσουν τήν οικογένεια. Συνέχισε της ποιώδες του μέ έξαιρετές επίδεσεις και μετά τό γυμνάσιο φοίτης, σύμφωνα μέ τά λεγόμενά του, «γιά τρία χρόνια σε μία διατέρα σχολή, στην οποία εξεπούλευτο κανείς μονάς στην έλληνική γλώσσα και στούς άρχοις συγγραφές. Ή συχτή βρισκόταν στην ίδια σκουφά, στο Κολονάκι. Άμεσως μετά τή σχολή έφυγα, 19 έτην, και πήγαινε στο Άγιον Όρος...». Έκει έγκατασθησε ο θαύματος της Αγίας Λαζαρίτης στην ιερά θέση της Αγίας Παναγίας Καλαμάτας.

Διακρίνεται γιά τη διάθεση φιλοξενίας, τήν κοινωνικότητα και τήν πινευματικότήτά του. Σύμφωνα μέ τήν Α.Θ.Π. τόν Οικουμενικό Πατριάρχη κ. κ. Βαρθολομαίο, «Ο δέιμαντος Γεράσιμος ήταν ένας από τους περισσιμένους λογιών μορφή τού Γένους ήμένων μάς τεραστίων παραγωγήν αριότου μυηνογραφικού έργου, συνέχισε την ιδίωσην παράδοσης των ύμνογράφων τής Αγίας ήμένων Θρασύδορου Εκκλησίας και κατεπούλησε μάντην δι' υπερδισκίων άικαλούμων, πολλαὶ τῶν όποιων είναι ἀνέκδοτοι. Εβραεῖσθαι ἐπανειλημμένως υπό διαφάρων, εν οἷς καὶ υπὸ τῆς Ακαδημίας Αθηνῶν.» (ἀπόδοσμα ἀπό οὐλία τῆς Α.Θ.Π. στή Θεσσαλονίκη, 1.10.1997).



ΜΙΧΑΛΗΣ ΑΔΑΜΗΣ

Ο Μιχάλης Αδάμης γεννήθηκε στον Πειραιά τό 1929. Όλοκλήρωσε στή Αθήνα τίς, σπουδές του στήν εύφωνη κατηγορία (συνέθεση μέ τόν Γ. Α. Παπαδάννου) και τήν βυζαντίνη μουσική, καθώς και στή Θεολογία, και άκολυθήμενος μεταπτυχιακές σπουδές στή σύνθεση, τήν ηλεκτρονική μουσική και τή βιζυαντίνη μουσικοπαιαγραφία στό Πανεπιστήμιο Μητραντής τής Βοστονής.

Έχει γράψει περισσότερα ἀπό τετρακόσια έργα γιά όρχηστρα, οργανικά και φωνητικά σύνολα, ηλεκτρονική μουσική, πολλά μέσα, καθώς και μουσική γιά τήν Εκκλησία, το Θέατρο και τή Τηλεόραση. Η διεθνής παρουσία του είναι πλούσια και συνεχής, μέ άνθεσεις ἀπό τούς μεγαλύτερους ποιητικούς όργανους, πλήθης έκτελέσεων και ραδιοφωνικών μεταδόσεων, βραβεύσεις και τιμητικές έκδηλωσεις. Παράλληλα μέ τή σύνθεση, σχολεύεται με τή Διεύθυνση και τήν ερεύνη στήν Βιζυαντίνη Μουσικολογία.

Τίρυσε καὶ διέθευν ονόμαστες τών Αθηνών, δημιούργησε τό πρώτο ηλεκτρονικό μουσικό έργοστήρι στήν Ελλάδα τό 1965, άνακοινωσε τό 1971 τήν άνακληση σε χειρόγραφο τού 15ου αι. τού όρχαιοτέρου δείγματος πολυφωνικής μουσικής στό Βιζάντιο, διέτελε πρόεδρος τού Ελληνικού Συνδέσμου Σύγχρονης Μουσικής (1978 – 1988) και τής ομάδας έργασσας γιά τήν Χορωδική Ανάπτυξη (1981 – 1984). Ως μέλος τής Διοικούσας Επιτροπής τού Ιανίου Πανεπιστημίου (1991 – 1994) έπιεργάζηκε προσαρτική τήν ίδρυση και κατέτησε τον προγράμματος σπουδών τού Μουσικού Τμήματος στό όποιο διδάξει και τού όποιου άναγορεύθηκε έπιτιμος διδάκτωρ τό 1999. Το 2004 άναγορεύθηκε διδάκτωρ τού τμήματος Μουσικών Σπουδών τού Πανεπιστημίου Αθηνών.

GERASIMOS, Monk of Little Saint Arne's on the Holy Mountain

Γεράσιμος Μικραγιαννάνης (1905 – 1991), his secular name being Anastasios - Athanasios, son of Ioannis Gkraikas and Athina Drossou, was born in Drovoghianni, in the province of Delvin in North Epirus.

In 1919 he moved with his father in Athens to work in order to assist the left behind family. He continued his studies with exceptional performance and accomplishments and after the Gymnasium he attended a school where, according to his sayings "it was three years in a higher school in which the students were taught only the Greek language and ancient Greek literature. The school was at Skoufa street in Kolonaki. After this school I left at the age of 19 years and came to Holy Mountain...". This was the place where he lived all his earthly life at the scete of Little Saint Anne in the cell of Timios Prodromos.

He was noted for his hospitality, sociability and his intellectual affluence. According to His All Holiness the Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, "The ever-rememberable Gerasimos was one of our most gifted and learned figures, producing a vast corpus of hymnography... he continued the unbroken tradition of the hymnographers of our Holy Orthodox Church and enriched her with over two thousand offices, many of which are unpublished. He was repeatedly honored with awards from various institutions, among which was the Academy of Athens." (excerpt from a homily given by His All Holiness in Thessalonica on 1.10.1997).



ΛΥΚΟΥΡΓΟΣ ΑΓΓΕΛΟΠΟΥΛΟΣ

Ο Λυκούργος Αγγελόπουλος γεννήθηκε στόν Πύργο Ήλειας τό 1941. Σπούδασε νομικά στό Πανεπιστήμιο Αθηνών και βυζαντίνη μουσική κοντά στό Σμύρναν Καρά, στό φερώνυμο Σύλλογο πρός Διδάσκων τής Εθνικής Μουσικής. Τό 1977 ίδρυσε και έκπτωσε διευθύνει τήν Ελληνική Βυζαντίνη Χορωδία.

Έχει σχοληθεῖ με τή σύγχρονη μουσική, έρμηνευόντας έργα κορών τού M. Λάζαρη, Δ. Τερζάκη, K. Σρέτασ, Γ. Κυριακάκη, J. Tavener κ.ά. Συμμετέχει στήν έρευνη τής ομάδα τού Marcel Pérez research team and has recorded Byzantine, Old Roman and Ambrosian chant as well as others of the old western chant in discs issued in France with the Ensemble Organum. His work *Les voix de Byzance* was published in France in 2005.

He has written numerous articles on the subject of Byzantine music.

In 1994 ή A.Θ.Π. ο Οικουμενικός Πατριάρχης κ. κ. Βαρθολομαίος τού διέπειν το διάρκειο τού Αρχοντος Πρωτοψάλτη τής Αρχιεπισκοπής Κωνσταντινούπολεως. Έχει τημηγέ, έπιστης, ἀπό τόν μακαριστό Πατριάρχη Ιεροσολύμων κυρό Διδώνω, τήν Εκκλησία τής Φιλανδίας, καθώς και ἀπό πολλές Μητροπόλεις τής Εκκλησίας τής Ελλάδος. Η Σεπτή Ιερά Σύνοδος τής Εκκλησίας τής Ελλάδος τού έχει όπονει δύο φορές τήν εύρεσειά τής Ελλάδος το παράσταση τού Απόστολου Παύλου. Τό 2004 ή A.E. ὡραίο πρόεδρος τής Ελληνικής Δημοκρατίας Κωνσταντίνος Stephanopoulos awarded him the honorary distinction of the Silver Cross of the Order of the Palm.

To date, he has written more than four hundred pieces for instrumental and vocal ensembles, orchestra, electro-acoustic and multi-media as well as music for the Church, the Theatre and Television. His presence on the musical scene is amply marked by commissions from major cultural organizations internationally, numerous performances and broadcasts, awards and honoraries. Besides composition he has engaged himself with Direction and with Research in Byzantine Musicology.

He has founded and directed major choral groups; he founded the first electronic music studio in Greece, in 1965; in 1971 he published his discovery and transcription of the oldest (15th c.), so far, sample of two-part Byzantine chant; he was President of the Greek Association for Contemporary Music (1978 – 1988) and of the Committee for Choral Development (1981 – 1984); as member of the Board of Directors of the Ionian University (1991 – 1994) he planned and organized the Department of Musical Studies in Corfu, which nominated him an honorary doctor in 1999. He was also nominated an honorary doctor in 2004 from the Department of Musical Studies of the University of Athens.
